The U.S.

Constitution

As used by our current government



WE THE CORPORATIONS in order to form more perfect profits, establish injustice, and insure foreign disharmony. Provide for the common offense, cut all general welfare,

and secure the blessings of our stock options, for the one percent and their posterity. Do ordain, and establish this Constitution for the Corporate States of America.

The Bill of No Rights Amendment One

Congress shall make any law it pleases that disrespects any established religion, as long
